REMEMBER the wish.

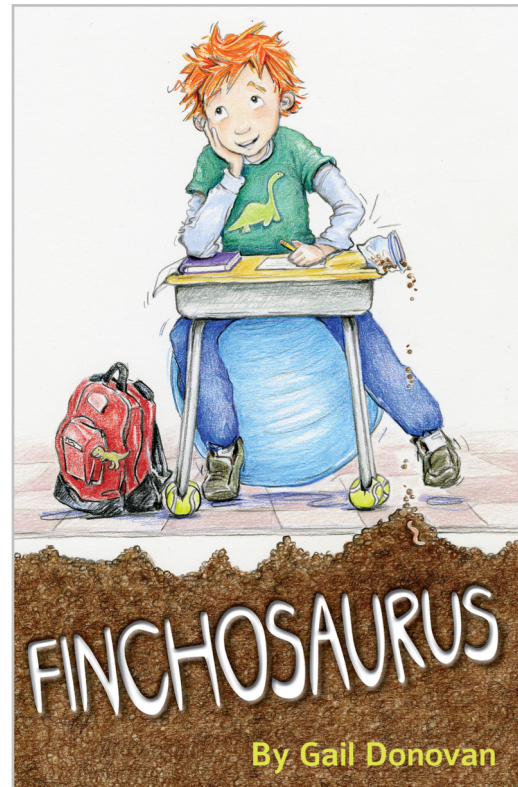
